# **Evergreens**

# Arborvitae, Techny

Our favorite outside row, windbreak tree. Popular in windbreaks and visual screens.

Very cold hardy, dense foliage.

Foliage: Glossy dark green

Shape: Upright oval

Height & Spread: 20 ft. by 10 ft.

Growth Rate: Moderate

#### Cedar, Eastern Red

A tough, native tree. Grows well in sandy soils. Not a common specimen tree. Great for windbreak, wildlife and conservation.

Foliage: Dark green

Shape: Upright pyramidal, irregular Height & Spread: 35 ft. by 20 ft.

Growth Rate: Moderate

### Fir, Concolor

Soft, rounded tip needles, easy to handle. Must have well drained soils. Will temporarily brown/winter-burn with below average temperatures.

Foliage: Silver-green Shape: Broad pyramid

Height & Spread: 50 ft. by 25 ft.

Growth Rate: Moderate

### Pine, White

Native to the Midwest. Hardy and fast growing. Typically will live 100+ years. Soft, three inch needles. Prefers moist, well drained soils.

Foliage: Green, soft needle

Shape: Pyramidal

Height & Spread: 60 ft. by 35 ft.

Growth Rate: Fast

### Spruce, Black Hills

Nice hardy conifer with dark green color. Will tolerate dryer soil and will withstand extreme seasonal conditions.

Foliage: Dark green Shape: Narrow pyramidal Height & Spread: 40 ft. by 20 ft.

Growth Rate: Slow

### Spruce, Colorado Blue

Blue, silver to dark green. Deer resistant. Used as an accent or ornamental, not windbreaks. Susceptible to disease problems at maturity.

Foliage: Blue and silver to dark green

Shape: Pyramidal

Height & Spread: 40 ft. by 20 ft. Growth Rate: Slow to moderate

### Spruce, Norway

Our favorite and most popular windbreak tree. Very hardy. Rapid growth. Prefers moist, well

drained soils. 100+ year lifespan.

Foliage: Dark green Shape: Pyramidal

Height & Spread: 60 ft. by 25 ft.

Growth Rate: Fast

## Spruce, White

A hardy windbreak and specimen tree. Good alternative to the Colorado Blue in mass plantings.

Foliage: Blue-green, small needle

Shape: Narrow pyramidal

# Hydrangea, Vanilla Strawberry

### Juniper, Blue Rug

Full centered growth habit. Very popular among the low growing, ground-covering Junipers. Commonly allowed to drape over a wall.

### **Lilac, Common Purple**

Traditional, showy, fragrant flowers in early spring. Used for color in landscapes or as Windbreak shrub. Spreads by suckering.

### Lilac, Betsy Ross

### Lilac, Miss Kim

Smaller, more compact and later flowering than the Common Purple Lilac. Slower growing than other lilacs.

## Ninebark, Coppertina

Copper-red all season. Flower: White with pink

Foliage: Copper

### Ninebark, Dart's Gold

Striking yellow provides great accent color. Used as hedge or specimen in landscapes.

Flower: White

Foliage: Yellow, lime green, bronze in fall

Shape: Round, compact Height & Spread: 5 ft. by 5 ft. Light: Partial shade to full sun

### Potentilla, Mango Tango

Continually blooming small flowers through fall.

Great color around outdoor living areas.

### Potentilla, Pink Beauty

Long lasting pink flowers. Use in mass

plantings or as a border.

## Rhododendron, Roseum Elegans

Most commonly used as an accent plant. Hardy in northern climates. Spring flowers look similar to that of a rose and a lilac. Fast grower.

Light: Partial sun

## Rose, The Double Knock Out

Unbelievable spring through fall color, with low maintenance. Disease resistant and drought tolerant. High centered, double flowers.

Foliage: Purple-green Shape: Compact, upward Height & Spread: 4 ft. by 3 ft.

Light: Partial sun

#### Rose, The Pink Double Knock Out

Pink version of the original, red, Double Knock Out. Low maintenance. Continuous spring through fall color.

Light: Partial sun

### Rose, Pink Drift

Low growing, spreading. Used as groundcover in front of other foundation plants or in mass plantings. Blooming spring through fall.

Light: Full sun

### Rose, Red Drift

Smaller than other Drift Roses. Uses are same as Pink Drift. Winter hardy and full of accent color.

Light: Full sun

## Spirea, Magic Carpet

Compact, red-tipped yellow foliage in spring turning to a yellow-green. Color can be used to brighten any landscape. Pink flower

Height & Spread: 2 ft. by 3 ft. Light: Full to partial sun

### Spirea, Neon Flash

Produces long-lasting neon-red flower clusters. Foliage changes from bright green to dark burqundy in fall.

### Spirea, Tor Birchleaf

Birch-like rich green leaves. White flowers in early spring. Foliage becomes copper or even gold, red and purple in fall.

Light: Full sun

### Weigela, Minuet

Produces lots of bright, fragrant flowers. Easy way to add a splash of color to a landscape.

Shape: Mound, compact Height & Spread: 2 ft. by 3 ft.

Light: Full sun

# Weigela, Wine and Roses

Dark burgundy foliage with rosy-pink flowers. Blooms in spring, and re-blooms throughout

# Windbreaks

### Design

Slowing the wind, controlling the snow drift and creating a visual barrier can all be done with the correctly designed plantings.

In agriculture, trees around livestock facilities can have a great impact on the operation and can even help in reducing odor.

For an effective windbreak we like to plant the inside row no closer than 75 feet away from the area you wish to protect to ensure snow has room to drift on the ground (not on your roof or driveway).

We have helped many home owners and farmers through the process of designing and planting windbreaks. We assist in plant selection to best suit your application, windbreak design, supplying nursery stock of all sizes, site layout and flagging, as well as installation of trees and shrubs.






- X = Techny Arborvitaes at 9 ft. spacing within the row
